uConnect News Bulletin:

Changes to the Victorian Training Guarantee

The BGK LLEN and Youth Connect have just been informed of changes to the eligibility criteria for the Victorian Training Guarantee. TAFE and RTOs were notified of these changes on February 2nd, 2012.

In brief, the changes state that as of today individuals accessing training under the VTG will be eligible to:

- Commence a maximum of two government subsidised courses in 2012; and
- Undertake training in no more than two government subsidised courses at any one time.

The intent of these changes is to maximise course completions by ensuring individuals are making more informed decisions about their training and employment opportunities and help drive individuals into higher level skills by limiting multiple enrolments at the same level.

We are currently seeking clarification regarding:

• Young people who enroll in VET courses as part of VETiS programs or when they are under 19 years of age, may subsequently enroll in another VET course at the same level. We would like to clarify if young people might also be eligible for an exemption from this new policy.

This clarification is vital for schools exiting students and for youth agencies trying to re-engage youth into education and training opportunities.

We have attached an information sheet that has some information in the form of Questions and Answers. As more information comes to hand we will pass it on.
