The Applied Learning Awards celebrate achievement in learning pathways such as Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETIS), School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SBATs) and the Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL). The Awards are coordinated by the Bayside Glen Eira Kingston Local Learning and Employment Network (BGK LLEN) and Youth Connect. Indeed, we hope that applicants will be able to use their responses when applying for other relevant applications and and awards in the future.
