The Awards are an initiative of the regional 'Applied Learning Network' and are coordinated by the Bayside Glen Eira Kingston Local Learning and Employment Network (BGK LLEN) and Youth Connect. - \* **VETiS Access Award** - for those providers enabling students to undertake VETiS programs externally
- \* **VCAL Provider Award** - for those secondary schools offering VCAL to students
- \* **Community VCAL Provider Award** - for those non-school providers offering VCAL to students
