What outcomes for students (including unexpected results, or results that have industry-wide / community-wide significance) have been achieved?

Have you contributed to a body of knowledge through activities such as speeches, program development, article development or visits to other organisations?

What student engagement methods (including those used with diverse cohorts, if relevant) have you implemented?

How have you assessed student needs and satisfaction and what actions have you taken in response to student feedback?
